Maysville Directory, 1871-72.

Maysville was for many years known as Limestone, from the creek of that name which empties in the Ohio. It was afterwards changed from Limestone to Maysville in honor of the owner of the land, Mr. John May, an intelligent and highly respectable gentleman from Virginia. In 1784, the first settlement at this place was made, and a double log-cabin and block house was built by Edward Waller, John Waller and George Lewis, of Virginia. The celebrated pioneer, Col. Daniel Boone, was a resident of this place in the year 1786, and erected a log house which still stands and can be seen in the rear of Mr. Hugh Gilmore's marble yard. During his residence here a party of seventy-five Indians came to the mouth of Fishing Gut Creek, the creek opposite this city on the Ohio side, to treat for the exchange of prisoners. Col. Boone, Jacob Boone, Col. Sharpe and Col. Logan went over to meet them. The wife of Col. Sharpe was one of the prisoners released. Col. Boone killed a fat beef for the occasion and the Indians had a feast and dance. The Indians were under a noted chief called Blue Jacket of the Shawanee tribe, and were so delighted with the entertainment given them that they made a solemn pledge to Col. Boone that if ever they met with a citizen from Maysville in suffering or captivity they would do all in their power to release them and alleviate their condi-This pledge they afterwards kept and released one prisoner whom they tion. treated with marked attention.

The first school was opened by Israel Donaldson, in the year 1790, who at one time was captured by the Indians. The school house was erected where the City Hall now stands, and was used on Sundays as a place of worship by the different denominations.

The progress of Maysville has been slow but steady, and at one time was the point of reception, storage, and trans-shipment of all merchandise and produce imported and exported by the north-eastern section of Kentucky, and to this day there is no doubt but what the greater portion of the business of the interior part of the State would have passed through here if the Maysville & Lexington Railroad had been completed a number of years ago. As it is, there is every indication, at present, of its early completion, and our little city may look forward to better days. In the midst of one of the most extended, imposing and attractive landscapes of "la belle Reivere," surrounded by a fertile and highly cultivated country, directly depending upon and tributary to her, with railroads

and facilities of transportation, Maysville must continue to advance in prosperity, population and wealth.

The amount of business done at Maysville is set down at \$12,500,000. Three papers are published at this point, the Maysville Bulletin, Eagle and Republican.
