45. Description and House Plan:

The unusual plan of this $1\frac{1}{2}$ -story, frame, double-pile, double-cell house-most double-cell houses in Kentucky are only one room deep--is matched by the unusual attention to detail and proportion. The eaves are bracketed and the attic vents are pointed. The front porch is shed-roofed with chamfered posts; the back porch, a smaller version of the front porch and also sheltering two doors, has recently been enclosed. All windows are 6/6 double-hung sash.

The principal parlor of the house, entered through the right door, is finished in the interior with crossette moldings and a Greek-Italianate arched mantel in wood. The left room, containing an enclosed staircase, single-run, to the upper half-story, is finished with mitered woodwork of modified Greek Revival profile. The upstairs walls are tongue-and-groove paneled.

The coal shed and privy, both gabled with vertical-board siding, may have been built at the same time as the house and post office, while the tool shed is recent. The coal shed and privy contribute to the 19th century feeling of the site, while the picket fence visually unites the house and post office, always linked by ownership.
