He was educated at the Augusta College, and taught school several years before entering upon the practice of his profession in 1871. He married Minerva, daughter of R. D. and Catharine (Walton) Smith, iz 1869, and they have a large family of interesting children. He has filled many important offices in the city and county, and is now the nominee of the Democratic Party for the office of County Judge.
