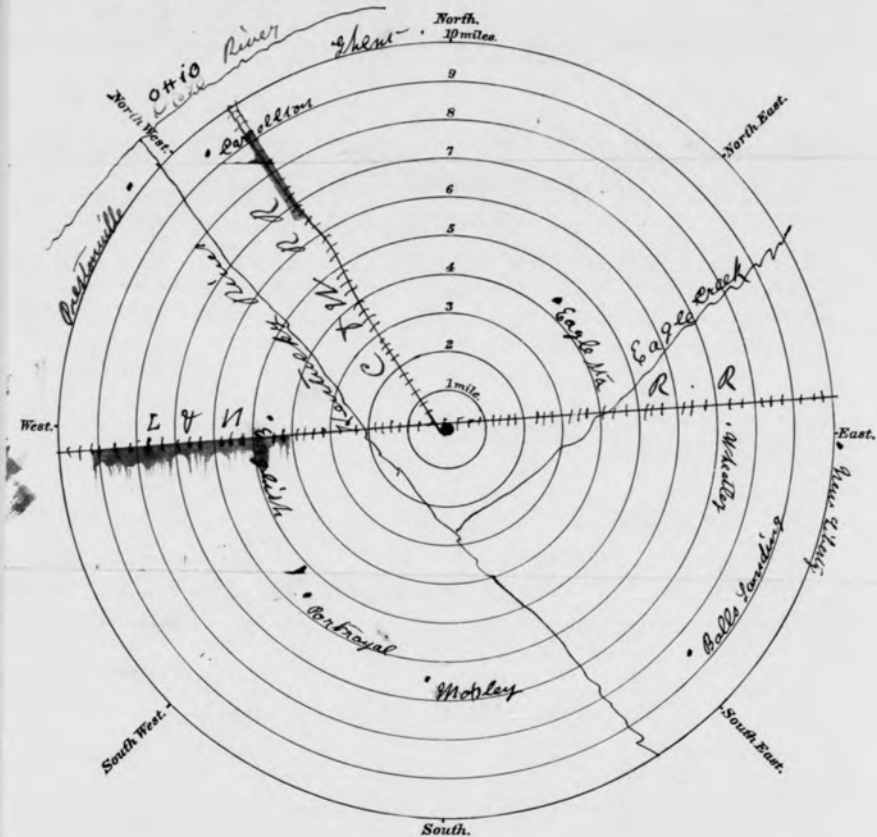

Main highways (name and show on margin name of town to which each road leads);

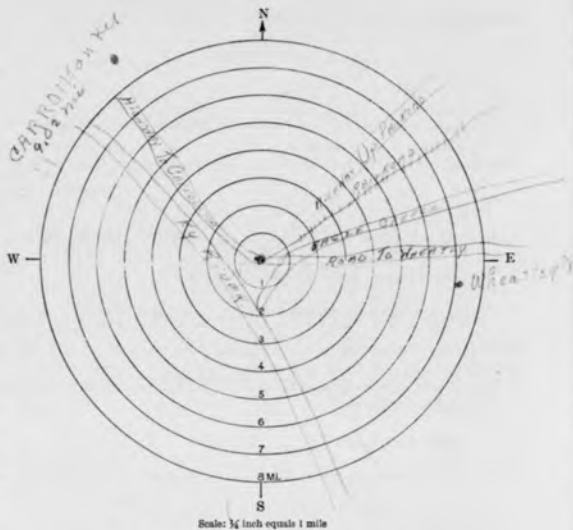
Rivers and creeks;

County line (show by dashes).

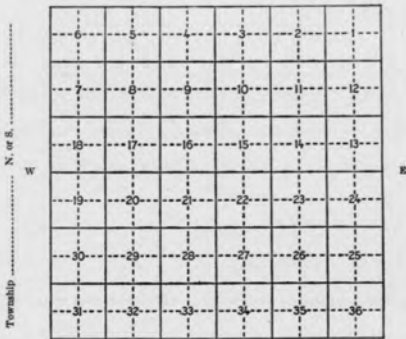
Letter the name on each item shown on the sketch.
