Newport, Kentucky

1876

situated on the Ohio river, at and above its confluence with Licking river, in the extreme northeastern part of the county, and immediately opposite the cities of Cincinnati, O., on the north, and Covington on the west. A magnificent iron railway bridge, built by the L., C. & L. R. R. in 1872, connects it with Cincinnati, and a wire suspension bridge, over which the street railway runs, connects it with Covington. It contains a court house, ten churches and a well-managed free high school as well as a number of district schools. Its principal manufactures are a rolling mill, iron foundry, three planing mills, a saw mill, flouring mill, brewery, distillery and steam freestone works, besides many smaller ones. There is a weekly newspaper published here called the Weekly Leader. The First National Bank, with a capital of \$100,000, does a good business. There is also a private banking house. Telegraph, Western Union. Express, Adams. Daily mail. Population 18,000. B. L. Winans, postmaster.
