WILSON, REV. ROBERT, Clergyman, was born in Virginia, in 1772, and came as a missionary of the Presbyterian Church to Kentucky, in 1798. He settled at Washington, in Mason County; organized the Churches at Maysville and Augusta; labored for the congregations of Smyrna, Flemingsburg, and other points; was possessed of great piety; was wholly devoted to the great work of his life; was unremitting in his efforts, leaving no opportunity to pass unappropriated to some good cause or work. He was greatly esteemed; and died at Washington, Mason County, October 31, 1822.
