

MAYSVILLE. Is the northern terminus of the Mays. div. K. C. R. R., and this, taken in connection with the superior shipping advantages presented by the Ohio river, make this city a point of considerable importance. It is beautifully situated on the southern bank of the river, 64 miles east of Cincinnati and 200 from Louisville, and is the seat of justice for Mason county. The mercantile and manufacturing interests here are extensive, and 5 newspapers, 3 banks, an opera house, 2 plow factories, 3 flour mills, a cotton mill, knitting factory, good public schools and churches of various denominations are sustained. The city has wide streets and avenues, is lighted with gas, and presents an attractive appearance. Good land is obtainable in the vicinity at reasonable prices.
