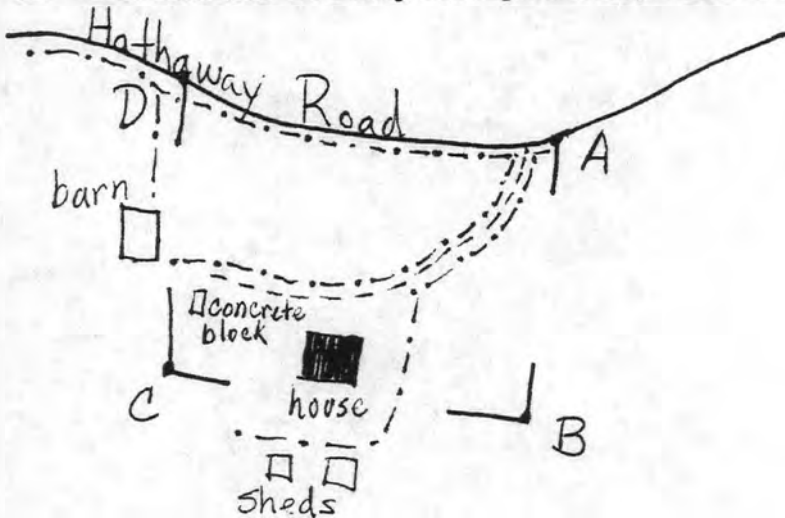

Beginning at a point 10' east of the driveway on the south side of Hathaway, proceed south 325'. Then proceed west northwest 550', turning north 325' to the south side of Hathaway Road. Then proceed 550' east along the south side of Hathaway Road to the point of origin. The boundary is drawn to include the hilltop on which the house was built.

45. Description and House Plan:

A low, rectangular mass, this house is covered with a shallow-pitched slate roof that incorporates a full-width front porch. The slender wooden columns of the porch are repeated at the corners of the house with engaged half-columns, and a band of shingles runs around the porch in place of an entablature. The exterior opening surrounds are of the simplest trabeated sort, and the windows are either 1/1 double-hung sash or 6/6. The only exterior alteration is the enclosing of the north end of a shed-roofed porch on the west side, itself a possible early addition. Craftsman style detailing is clearer in the interior finishing than in the exterior.

The gabled concrete-block shed does not contribute to the property since it was constructed in the last several decades. A barn and two sheds near the house are not included in the boundaries. A white board fence separates the drive and house from the pastureland and outbuildings, except the concrete block building.
