This double pile house also features small attic vents and a bracketed cornice. Roof supported by roughly cut common rafters

Ensweiler's father is reputed to have built the stone outbuildings. In 1909 John Heeb purchased the farm; he was also a native of the Four Mile Creek area and member of St. Joseph's Church. Heeb's parents were born in Switzerland. In addition to cattle and hogs, the Heebs raised grapes, turnips, cabbage, and potatoes on the farm.

Vinegar and cider were stored in the cellar. Mrs. Louise Heeb Sandfos is John Heeb's daughter.




