A later fram ell on the right rear incorporates a summer kitchen, which was moved forward to the rear elevation. Original house is single pile with center hall passage. Alterations include an exterior stove flu and aluminum entrance canopy.

Simple interior woodwork except for the center hall staircase, which consists of a turned newelpost and balustrade.

The Walter property also includes a rectangular bank barn immediately west of the garage, a samll bank-type stone fruit cellar, and a recessed stone storage cavity presently used to store galvanized garbage cans.

19. 21 year old Walter built his handsome stone I house. He had grown up in a two-story, one-room log structure located on his father's (George Walter) nearby farm. Walter, a blacksmith by trade, had two children and a farm laborer living in the house in 1880. The stone blacksmith's shop was demolished approximately 20 years ago. This farm has remained in the Walter family.




