

North facade has imbricated and square shingles on gambrel face, same decoration in gable end. Stained glass window. West facade has same decoration, 3 bay open porch with turned posts, machine cut trim. Rear door. Interior--door trim with corner blocks and tracery, mantels have tile facing around fireplace.
